Responsibilities may include:

1. Welcome clients to our drop-in center
2. Assist with the client intake process
3. Offer support to our clients while in the drop-in center.
4. Assist in keeping on with schedules for shower, laundry, closet, pantry, lockers, etc.
5. Serve meals to clients during lunch hour (or dinner).
6. Engage with clients who are visiting the Drop-In center, games, cooking, arts, crafts.
7. Sensitive to the needs of clients from the LGBTQ+ community.
8. Support outreach events such as canvas on known hot spots, distribute kits, pass out flyers.
9. Maintain all client and organization sensitive information confidential.
10. Be respectful and compassionate to clients coming to our Drop-In Center.
11. Arrive on time for duty and remain professional in your interactions with all clients and colleagues

Expectations:

- Learn about the organization and its policies;
- Get an orientation to the organization and training for your volunteer role;
- Ask for and have regular reviews or evaluations of your performance;
- Get guidance and support in your volunteer role.
